

“The 2008 AIDS Vancouver Custom Chopper” Contest Official Contest Rules and Regulations

How To Enter: **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY**. Commencing January 10, 2008, 12:01am (PST), each time you make a donation (\$20.00 for one entry, \$50.00 for four entries, \$100.00 for nine entries) to the Vancouver AIDS Society by either donating in person or on-line at www.vancouverchopper.com, www.aidsvancouver.org, or by calling our toll free number 1-877-512-3321, your name will be entered into the Contest. No tax receipts will be issued for any donations made through either the toll free number or the website link.

In order to obtain one entry into the Contest by not making a donation, send, in an envelope with sufficient postage, a minimum 250 word unique hand written essay on the topic of *“AIDS Awareness in the 21st Century,”* along with your first name, last name, home telephone number, full address and email address (if any) to:

All entry forms/donations must be completed and/or postmarked before 11:59 p.m. (PST) October 1st, 2008 (“Contest Closing Date”).

Prize: One (1) custom made Vancouver Custom Chopper Phantom II motorcycle. The prize must be accepted as awarded. Estimated retail value of prize is Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000.00) (Canadian Dollars).

The Drawing: The random draw for the prize will take place in North Vancouver, British Columbia on or around October 10, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. (PST) at the offices of Vancouver Custom Chopper Motorcycles Ltd. based on all eligible entries received.
